Kumite Rules

All divisions are listed above; however, the tournament directors reserve the right to split divisions or combine divisions as needed.

Tournament will run 3 or 5 Judge/Referees as needed.

Kumite Match Times:

1.5 minutes stop time	13 years old and under
2 minutes stop time	14 years old and older
3 minutes stop time	18 - 34 advanced

Rules will follow USANKF/WKF modified rules. Head gear is optional for all divisions! The tournament director reserves the right to adjust any rule for the safety and fairness of competition.

There is NO repechage in any division.

No contact to the head for ages 11 and under. Light skin touch with a foot is allowed for ages 12 and up divisions. Ages 16 and up (non-injurious, "light skin touch") with a hand is allowed.

Sweeps are allowed for <u>all</u> ages and divisions.

Kumite Equipment:

Mandatory: Mouth Guard for all competitors. Groin cup (boys/men only)

Optional: Head gear (recommended), Face mask, Chest Protector

Kata Rules

Flag system to be used in all divisions!

<u>Beginner and Novice Divisions:</u> Competitors will perform simultaneously. Competitors may perform only kata from the USANKF beginner/novice list. Competitors may repeat kata in all rounds.

<u>Intermediate Divisions:</u> Competitors will perform simultaneously. Competitors may perform only kata from the USANKF intermediate list. Competitors may repeat kata in all rounds.

Please note: Empi maybe performed in this division.

<u>Advanced Divisions:</u> Competitors will perform simultaneously. Competitors may perform any kata from the USANKF list. Competitors must perform a different kata in medal rounds (not performed in previous round).

18-34 Advanced Kata Divisions

Competitors perform kata one at a time in all rounds.

Kobudo Rules

All divisions will use a scoring card system.

Beginners will be	5 - 7 point range
Intermediate will be	6 - 8 point range
Advanced will be	7 - 9 point range

Kobudo includes all traditional Okinawan weapons and Japanese weapons.
