2-Introduction

The Los Angeles Karate Championship is one of the most important karate-Do events of the United States and complies with high level of presentation. Initiated in 2016, the 2019 edition is formed to gather participants from Southern California, Northern California, Las Vegas, Arizona, Texas, Mexico, New Jersey, Florida, Columbia, Guatemala, Puerto Rico, Haiti, France, India, Russia, Armenia, Peru, Ecuador and Japan; thus increases karate's influence over the world in a global scale. The UASK and the City of Los Angeles in the heart of Hollywood located at westwood are hosting this karate event the third time.

At the end of the each division, all champions are presented with a "grand winner award". In order to receive the award, competitors have to show good behavior (sportsmanship) while performing in their respective category.

3-UASK Approved items

The UASK items to be used during the Los Angeles Karate Championship will comply with WKF and USANKF regulations with regard to safety of our athletes. In order to guarantee better delivery of the event, and to ensure a suitable quality of tournament, inclusive brands are welcomed with approval of our tatami managers onsite during our championship. We will have four (4) rings available to all divisions, including a gymnastic room for staging and preparation.

8-Categories

The competition categories are identical to USA National Tournament with the exception of kumite open & kata mixed teams (kata team mixed will be set onsite). There will be "NO REPECHAGE" during this tournament. No kobudo or para-karate division will be available this year.

9-Entry Fee

The entry fees are \$60 per individual and \$10 for each additional division except Elite, which is \$100 per competitor.

10-Payment

All payment must be processed through the online platform. Onsite will require \$35 late fees regardless your division and no refund will be issued once paid.

11-UASK Accredited coach

According to USANKF manual, all coaches require a minimum level of training to be able to obtain such certification, coaches must attend a compulsory coach briefing prior the event with exception of PKF/WKF accredited coaches.

A payment of \$50 will be taken on site prior each seminar (Kobudo, Karate-Do, Coaching, and Referee) and \$25 for audit. If you with to take more than one seminar you will be qualified for a discount.
